

## **RABBI SIMON ALTAF HAKOHEN, ALL IS WELL...**

Note this article/Teaching is based on my true life events.

All along our life we go through some difficult challenges and sometimes we are so worn out by our challenges that we want to give up. People usually have breakdowns when they are facing difficulties and they feel they cannot catch up with all their problems and they allow the whole problem situation to surmount to such a level that boom they breakdown just a computer overwhelmed with a virus, if we don't deal with it, the bug/virus crashes the computer.

When I was called out by God that was the greatest moment in my life, I was so elated but only I knew and understood what this moment meant for me. I knew I would face many difficulties and challenges in my family and what mattered was not that my whole family comes out of the fire so to speak but what mattered was me. If I felt that would destroy my whole family so I had to stand tall and absolutely sure of myself.

So I told myself ALL IS WELL. Then my whole world started to fall apart, my ex-wife thought I had gone religious crazy, my daughter was young she did not know what to think of her father, my wider family just thought I was nuts why would I follow YESHUA (Jesus) of Nazareth, the Messiah. They thought why he wants to follow the English people who eat pork, they live unclean, they eat unclean, is this man crazy.

To them they measured everything by sight, not by faith. They would judge people by sight and they did not understand that God works somewhat differently and not necessarily how people eat.

At that point I decided not to fight with my ex-wife but I would go into my room and encourage myself, I would meet other believers and they would encourage me.

24 And let us consider one another to provoke to obedience and to good works of Torah:

25 Not forsaking the Israelite assemblies of gathering together, as the manner of some is; but exhorting one another: and so much the more, as you see the day approaching.<sup>1</sup>

So it's very important that we meet like minded believers and be encouraged. We must never allow negativity to destroy our vision for life and health.

We must always keep our focus on the things of God and tell ourself ALL IS WELL.

In the Bollywood Indian movies there is an actor whose very famous his name is Amitabh Bachchan in the movie Toofan, it was real catchy ([https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=owe\\_1QZhmfQ](https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=owe_1QZhmfQ)), I used to watch a lot of his movies in Hindi. In this movie he sings the song, Bahir hay problem, gar may hay problem, agay peechay ajoo bajoo problem hi problem, basically saying outside is a problem, In the House is a problem, even around us left and right we have problems but don't worry and be happy. I used to sing that song a lot. It came to pass that I had that same situation, problem at home and problems outside.

Basically that song was called into my life, so be careful what you sing you will call into your life, if you sing sadness, you will call sadness into your life, my crutch was I guess that I received eternal life and that became a problem for everybody around me.

I had been telling myself for 10 years and others that God would speak to me and God did indeed speak to me so I called it in. That was a good thing.

This taught me a very important lesson, our words are powerful and use them wisely.

Our Master YESHUA said the following:

Yochanan (John) 17:8

For I have given to them the words which you gave me; and they have received them, and have known surely that I came out from you, and they have believed that you did send me.

YESHUA said "I have given to them the words which you gave me."

How did He give them these words? Did he carry books? No, as there was not a single book then called The Bible, clearly he gave them words by speech and His disciples realised what those words were and what they meant and understood them and accepted them. So He spoke!!

Speech has power. If you give someone some words, they can do one of two things, they can believe you or reject you or there is a third, they go and slander you!!!

I have been through all three of the above where I gave words to the people, some accepted them, while others rejected them and some went on further and slandered me.

Don't be disheartened, this is common but we the chosen seed of God are not common, we are a special creation and called the Chosen and those that are called.

In the Bible there is a story of a woman called the Shunamite in the book of 2 Kings 4-8-37.

She is a wealthy woman and she asks her husband to build Elisha the prophet a room so he can stay there whenever he passes through their district. Elisha seeing the woman's good hearted faith offers a gift to her knowing that her husband was old that she will have a son which he knew she was lacking. She gives birth to a son and later that son dies, let's pick up the story there.

2 Kings 4:25-26

So she went and came to the man of Elohim to Mount Carmel. And it came to pass, when the man of Elohim saw her afar off, that he said to Gehazi his servant, Behold, there at a distance is that Shunammite: Run now, I beseech you, to meet her, and say to her, Is it shalom with you? Is it shalom with your husband? Is it shalom with the child? And she answered, It is shalom.

The prophet Elisha asked her, is it well and the woman said yes ALL IS WELL.

The truth is that her son had died, she would in normal circumstances would be wailing and crying bitterly but this woman revealed an incredible truth, that is do not verbalise your problems, keep your mouth shut and say ALL IS WELL.

So from now on you must say ALL IS WELL, even when you have situations, you must not verbalise the negative thoughts else you will just make your situation even more worse than before.

In The Bible we are told the story of Sarah when God had told Abraham that he would have a son of promise. Both Abraham and Sarah are old in age and think how is it possible that me and my wife who are way past child bearing age can have children so they wait a few years that is at least 11 years pass but no child is born, then Sarah tells Abraham to take on her maidservant and marry her for wife and produce a child from her womb.

Abraham complies agreeing with Sarah that perhaps you are right we could be thinking the wrong thing then Ishmael is born. See what happened?

Both Sarah and Abraham verbalised the wrong thing, they instead of believing the son is from their bodies thought it must come from someone else so they then called it in, they birthed Ishmael.

Likewise our words have power, we must not believe in the wrong thing and birth Ishmael but we must wait on the promise God has given us and with that we can succeed in any obstacles or difficulty.

The Lord Jesus, Master YESHUA of Nazareth stated the following:

Mark 11:23-24

For verily I say to you, That whosoever shall say to this mountain, Be you removed, and be you cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he said shall come to pass; he shall have whatever he said.

Therefore I say to you, whatever things you desire, when you petition, believe that you receive them, and you shall have them.

We are humans just like Sarah and Abraham, we can have doubts as they had the doubt also but the important thing is not to verbalise it and call it in. So believe in Good things and good will come, if you believe in the negative then you are calling it in.
